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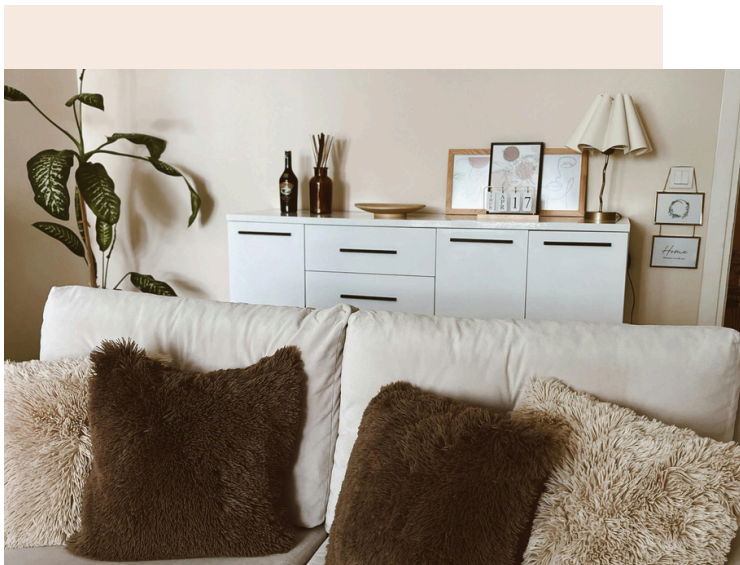

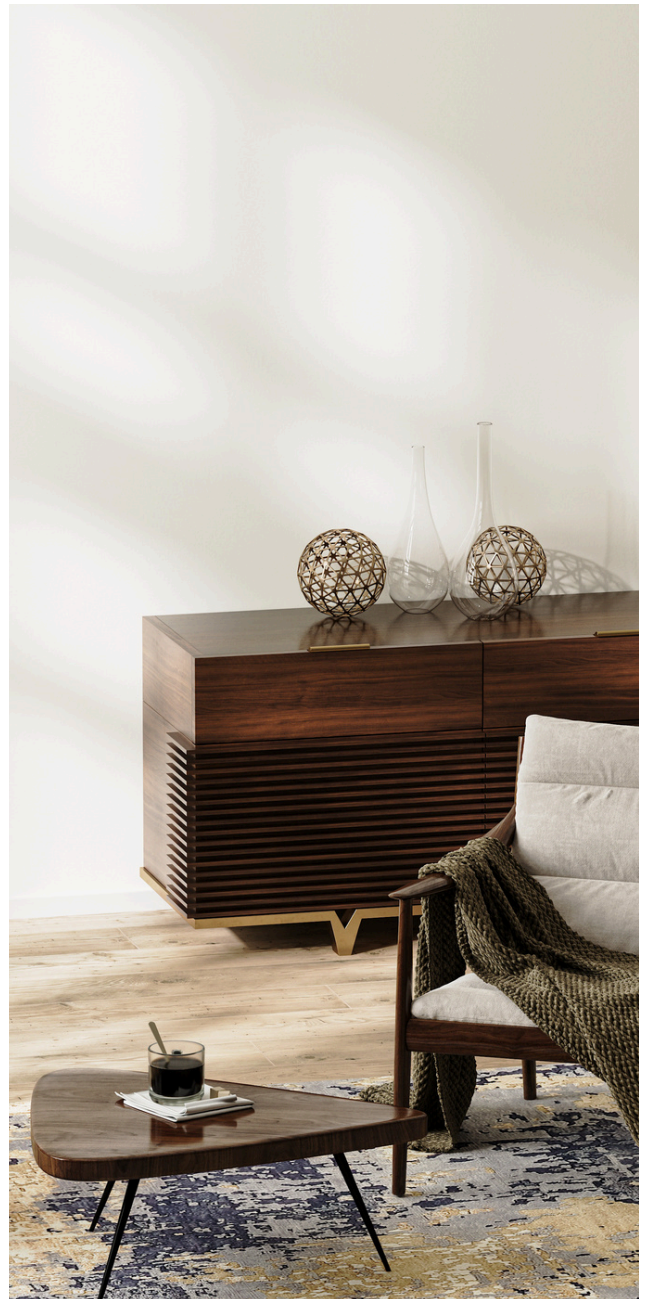

# THE FAMILY CONVERSATION

- Items with resale value
- Things you've been holding "just in case"

Look beyond the price of the home:

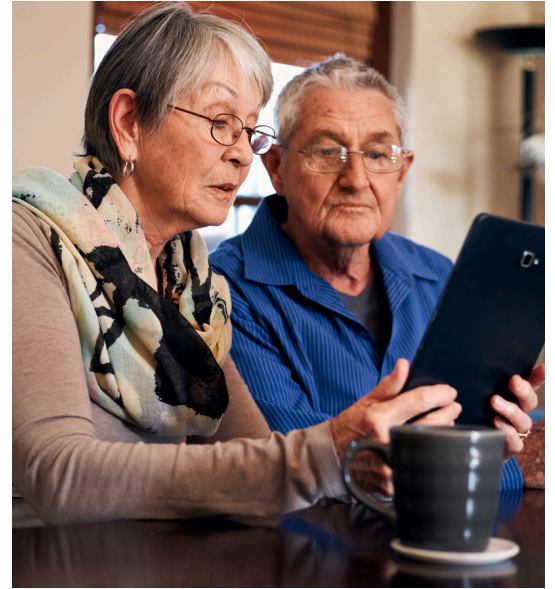
- HOA fees

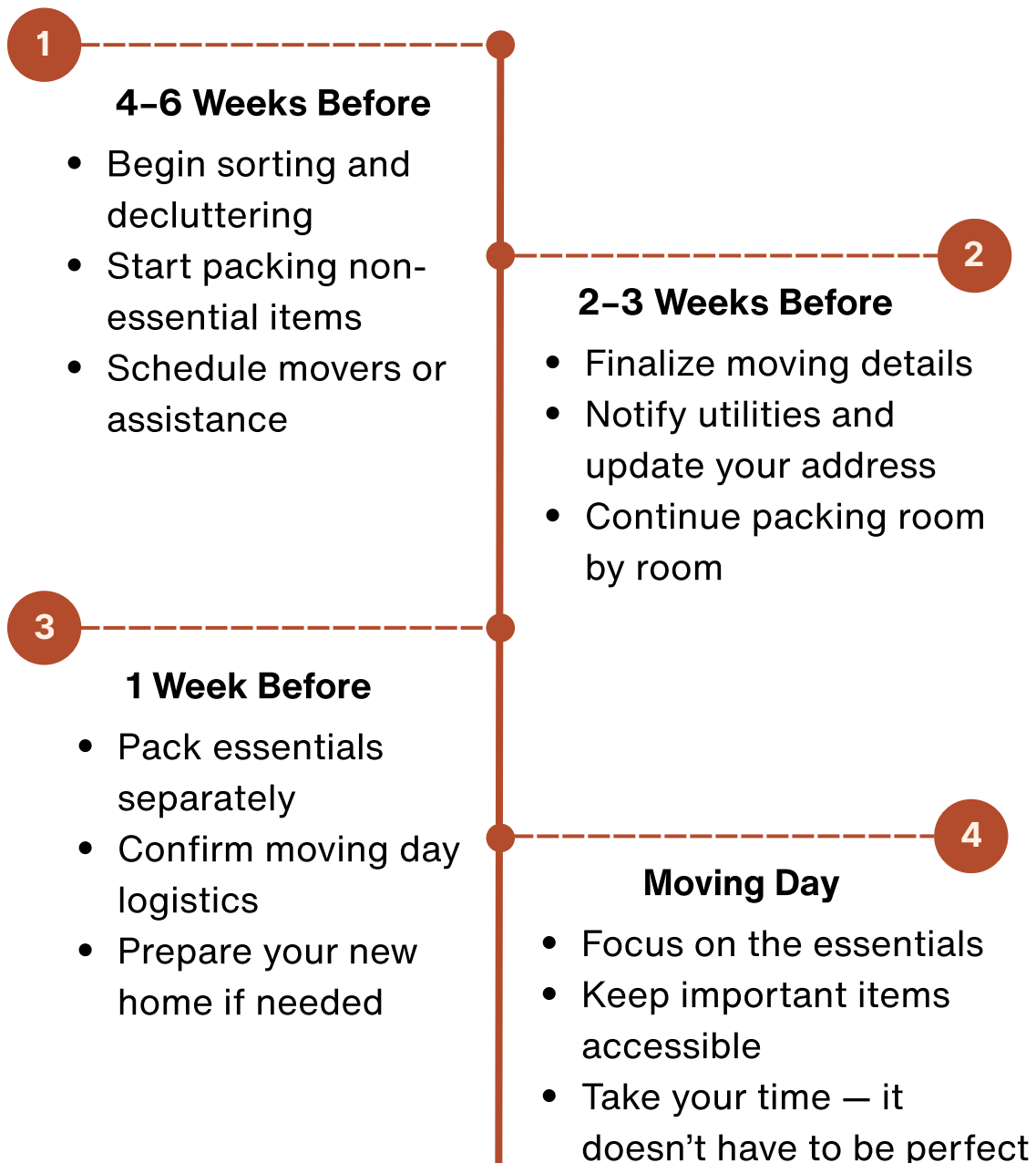
Focus on how the home supports your lifestyle — not just how it looks.
