UNDERSTAND YOUR FINANCIAL READINESS

Buying your first home starts with understanding where you are financially – not where you think you should be.

You don't need everything to be perfect. You just need a clear starting point. Most buyers are closer than they think – they just need the right information to move forward with confidence.

Where to Start:

Before looking at homes, it helps to have a simple understanding of:

- what you can comfortably afford
- what upfront costs to expect
- how lenders evaluate your finances



WHAT LENDERS TYPICALLY LOOK AT

● ► YOUR CREDIT SCORE

Your credit score helps determine your loan options and interest rate. Many loan programs allow flexibility – and improvements can be made over time.

● ► YOUR INCOME & STABILITY

Lenders look for consistent income and a stable work history. This helps show that you can comfortably manage a monthly payment.

● ► YOUR SAVINGS

Your down payment doesn't have to be large – some programs allow as little as 3–5%. It's also important to plan for closing costs, which can include lender fees, title, and escrow.

✘ Instead of asking: *“Am I ready to buy?”*

✔ Start with: *“What would I need to feel ready?”*



SMART MOVE:

Start by understanding your numbers – not guessing them. Even a simple conversation can give you clarity and direction.

GET PRE-APPROVED WITH CONFIDENCE

Before you start seriously looking at homes, there's one step that makes everything clearer: getting pre-approved.

WHY IT MATTERS:

Pre-approval helps you:

- ✓ understand your price range

- > recent bank statements
- > permission to check your credit
- > employment information

- > you can start viewing homes with confidence
- > you'll be ready to make a strong offer when the time comes
